



30-inch municipal sewer outfall helps Shafter Avenue

The City of Shafter, Calif. began installation of 10,700 feet of 30-inch HDPE pipe in June of 1999. The project involved installing an outfall line from the city's primary waste water treatment facility to a secondary treatment facility located two miles away.

In a unique fashion, the City of Shafter designed the project in-house and installed the pipeline with city construction crews. HDPE pipe was selected as the most economical option.
