



California Department of Transportation uses HDPE pipe to improve sanitary sewer line

In March of 1999, Rising Sun Construction, Inc. began construction of a major bypass improvement sewer on State Highway 198 located in Visalia, California. Included in the scope of the project was the installation of 7,300 linear feet of 30-inch diameter HDPE pipe to be used as an outfall line. This sanitary sewer line was subsequently turned over to the City of Visalia after completion of the project.

The contractor selected HDPE pipe for this particular application due to the ease of installation and lower cost as compared to other specified materials such as vitrified clay pipe, PVC-lined concrete pipe and other profile-wall thermoplastic pipes.
