



HDPE pipe used in SPCC Torata River Project

In 2000, the Southern Peru Copper Corporation in Peru decided to expand the Cuajone mine. The expansion of the mine required the diversion of the Torata River to access the deposits located under the river and river basin areas. ECI was retained and designed the Torata River diversion project using large diameter HDPE pipe.

The project utilized approximately 2,400 feet of 63-inch (1600mm) HDPE pipe. The pipeline system is currently in operation, and is expected to provide trouble free service for many years to come.
